

SHODAIR VISITATION POLICY 11/10/2021

The hold on family visitation with patients on the acute units and residential units has been lifted. There are specific requirements that must be met prior to scheduled visit as well as the day of planned visit.

A social services employee will be responsible for the coordination and scheduling of visitation. They will be responsible for explaining the visitation policy to parent/guardian. This will entail asking about vaccination status and explaining testing requirements.

In addition, **parents/guardians must agree to wear a medical grade mask during visit with patient.**

PRE-VISIT

1. Parents/guardians will be asked about their vaccination status.
2. If they report being fully vaccinated, then proof of vaccination is required.
3. If they are not fully vaccinated or decline to disclose their vaccination status, they will be required to take a *rapid antigen test at Shodair*. (Notify Lisa Marcille FNP of a positive antigen test).

DAY OF VISIT

1. When the parent/guardian arrive at the Shodair Facility they will be met by Shodair receptionist Cathyann or other designated person for that day.
2. Visitors will be asked to show their proof of vaccination.
3. They will be asked to complete a covid high/low risk screening form. This form is required for all visitors regardless of vaccination status.
4. If they have any high-risk symptoms, they will be asked to leave facility immediately.
4. If they have low risk symptoms, they will need to complete a rapid antigen test regardless of vaccination status. (Notify Lisa Marcille FNP of a positive antigen test).
5. Testing will take place in the admissions office.
6. Visitors that are fully vaccinated and without symptoms do not need to take rapid antigen test.
7. Once screening info is completed Cathyann, or employee from admissions office will escort visitor to visitation room. An employee from the unit will escort patient to visitation room.

All residential kids will utilize the Glacier conference room. Refer to Glacier conf room on Public Folders and Shodair room schedule; find an available time and contact Cathyann to reserve the room.

All acute kids will utilize the Acute Classroom at this time. Refer to Public Folders and Shodair room schedule; find an available time and contact Cathyann to reserve the room.

**(patients on SP1 will not be able to have visits until the acute units are able to access those cameras from the unit).*

Visits are limited to one hour.

At this time visitation is limited to parents/guardians only.

Visits need to occur Monday through Friday during business hours 0900-0300.

If a visit is required outside of this time frame, then the therapist or individual scheduling the visit will need to be present the day and time of visitation to assist in screening and/or testing of visitors.
